What Is A VSL?

<u>V</u>ideo <u>S</u>ales <u>L</u>etter

- Sales Copy In A Video Format With Voice.
 - ✓ The Common Format Is To Use PowerPoint Presentations And Record With Video Screen-Capture Software.

However, As Seen In The Previous Lesson, Other Common Types of Video Are "White Board" and "Explainer" Videos.

Why Are They Effective?

 Because They Deliver The Important Information And Benefits Of The Product To The Prospective Customer In A "Spoon Fed" Method Ensuring They Do Not Miss Critical Info That Ultimately Benefits Them And Makes Them Want To Buy.

Video Is Also An "Entertaining"/Less Boring Way To Deliver A Message And Can Trigger Emotion Through Voice Inflections, Sound, Visual Images, Etc.

What's Needed?

Sales Copy / Script.

- ✓ PowerPoint or Keynote.
 - Alternative To Microsoft PowerPoint is <u>OpenOffice.org</u> (Free Clone)
- ✓ Screen Capture Software (Camtasia <u>TechSmith.com</u>, or Alternative).
- ✓ Voice-Over Audio (See <u>Fiverr.com</u>).

What's Needed?

Final Video In **MP4 Format**. Camtasia Can Render To This Format. Or You Can Use A Free Tool Like <u>Handbrake.fr</u> To Convert Non-MP4 Video Into This Format.

✓ Video Player (Such As JW Player Or Flow Player) To Display The Video On Your Web Page. Or Alternatively, Use A Service Like <u>EasyVideoSuite.com</u> or <u>Wistia.com</u> For Managing Videos, Players, Auto-Conversion To Web Ready Format.
