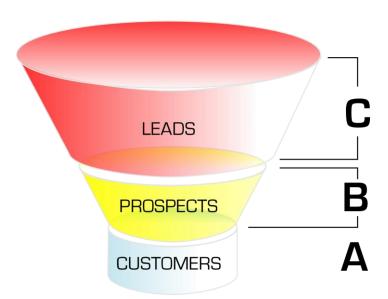

First, Let's Identify All Of The Pages And Elements You're Going To Need In Your Sales Funnel...



□ Email-Capture **Landing Page** (aka, Opt-In Page) is Designed With One Purpose: To Get The Email.



□ **Follow Up Emails** Scheduled Into An Autoresponder That Repeatedly Send Leads Back To Sales Page (5-7 Times).

□ Sales Pages

- ✓ Primary Front-End Product Sales Page (Either VSL or Text More On This In Module #11).
- ✓ Upsell Sales Page(s).
- ✓ Downsell Page(s).



- □ **Affiliate Page** (If Accepting Affiliates).
 - ✓ To Include "Signup" Info, Sales Stats, Promotional Tools (Email Swipes, Graphics, Etc), and Training.



□ Support Page

✓ Simple Page That Tells Them How To Contact You For Support To Include Average Response Time, Hours, Etc. Include Your Support Email On This Page Or If Using A Help Desk, Provide A Clickable Hyperlink.

Customer Registration Page

✓ Page Where Customers Opt-in To Your Email Database For Future Updates, Bonuses, Offers, Content, etc.

*This Page Redirects To The Download Page After Form Submission or Redirects to Upsell/Downsell Funnel.
